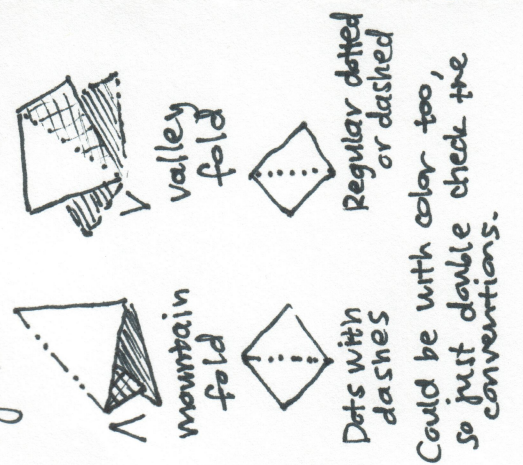


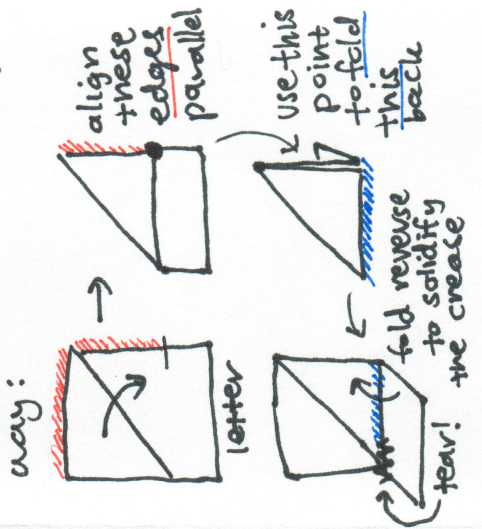
So you want to learn how to fold origami?

There are two kinds of primary folds, notated by different line styles.



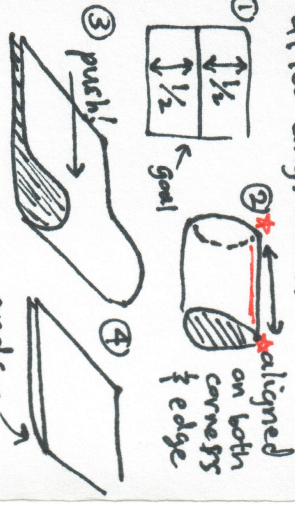
Often, it starts by giving a square paper access to origami paper, you can use standard paper in the following way:

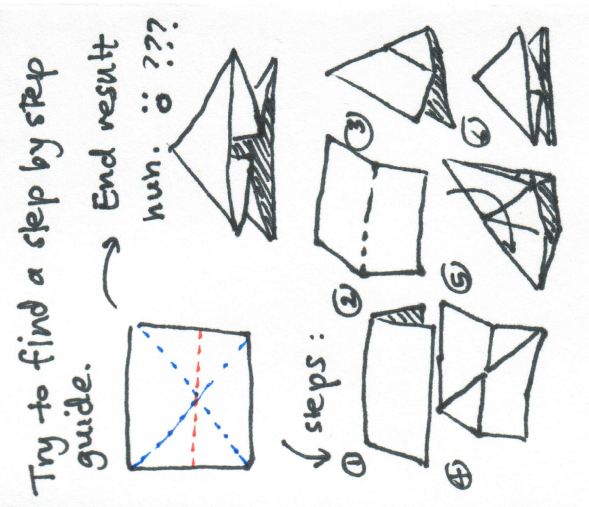

Other points of technique: push or pull toward a fold after alignment

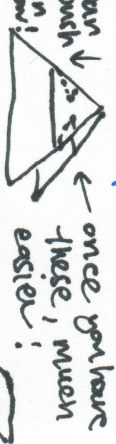
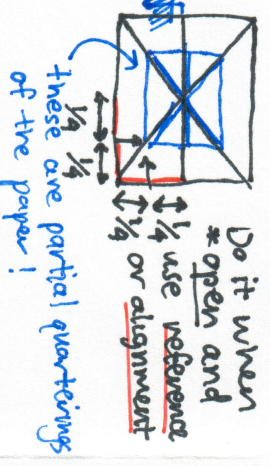


Errors build up! perpendicularity of edges and alignment of 90° folds or evenness of divisions affect later folds. You will be rewarded for meticulousness!

If you see a diagram with all the folds and their directions labeled, it will be confusing. (at first)



Example where creasing both ways help:



*Why when open? Folding multiple layers means round creases!

Just because something is notated as a mountain or valley doesn't mean you can't fold it the other way. Sometimes, doing both helps!
